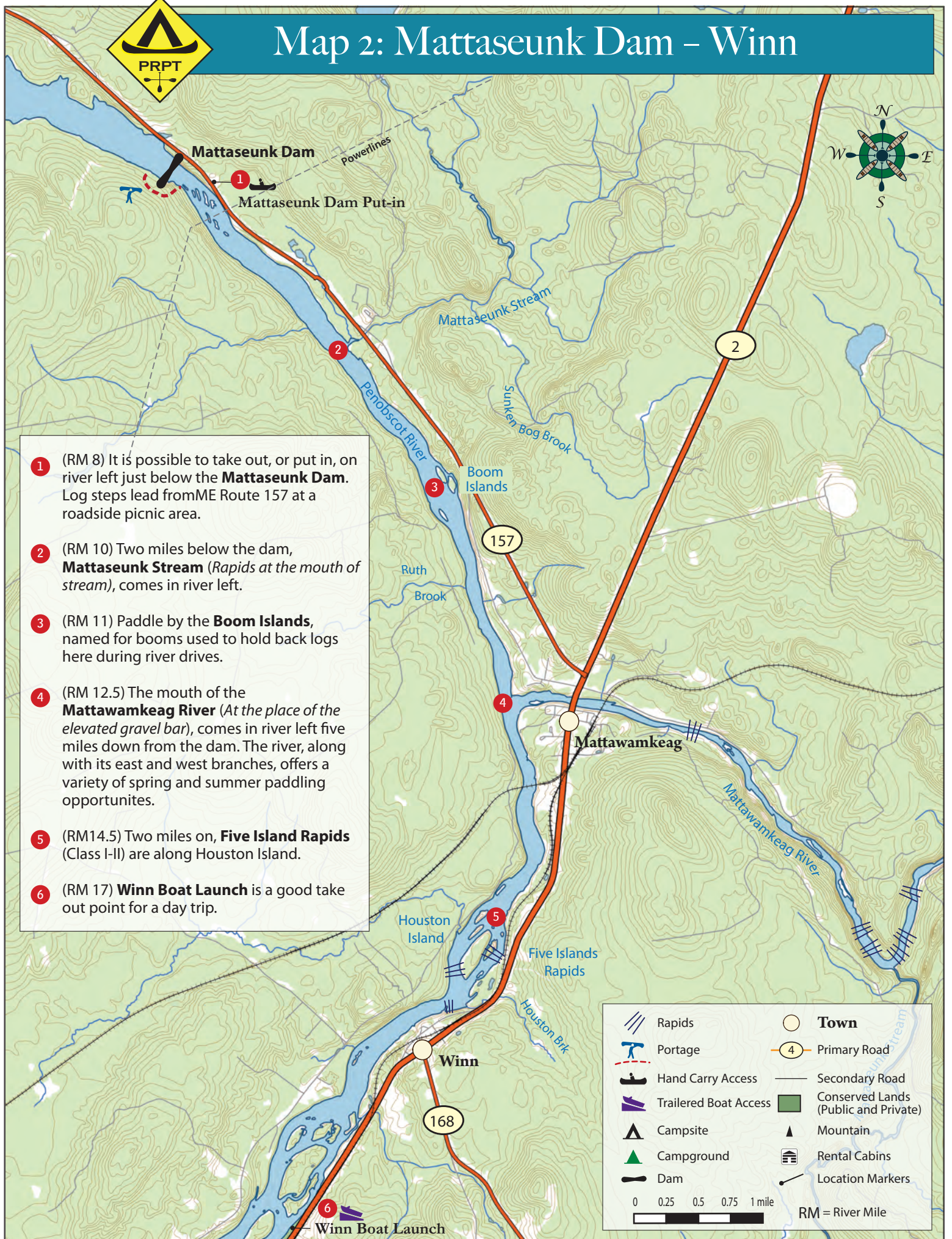


# Map 2: Mattaseunk Dam – Winn



- 1 (RM 8) It is possible to take out, or put in, on river left just below the **Mattaseunk Dam**. Log steps lead from ME Route 157 at a roadside picnic area.
- 2 (RM 10) Two miles below the dam, **Mattaseunk Stream** (*Rapids at the mouth of stream*), comes in river left.
- 3 (RM 11) Paddle by the **Boom Islands**, named for booms used to hold back logs here during river drives.
- 4 (RM 12.5) The mouth of the **Mattawamkeag River** (*At the place of the elevated gravel bar*), comes in river left five miles down from the dam. The river, along with its east and west branches, offers a variety of spring and summer paddling opportunities.
- 5 (RM 14.5) Two miles on, **Five Island Rapids** (Class I-II) are along Houston Island.
- 6 (RM 17) **Winn Boat Launch** is a good take out point for a day trip.
