



# Map 4: Mattanawcook – Mohawk Island

- 1 (RM 25.5) **Medunkeunk Landing Campsite** is located 1/10 of a mile up this tributary. Medunkeunk means “quick drop”, referring to a waterfall upstream of the campsite.
- 2 (RM 26) **Mattanawcook Island** was the central Wabanaki village for centuries and is no longer populated. Mattanawcook comes from Matenenakok (*Short stream before reaching the lake*) and is applied to a lake, a stream, and the island.
- 3 (RM 28) Pass under a **high bridge**.
- 4 (RM 30) High, scenic **Mahockanock Island** (*Island of elevated land, Turtle island*) can be passed on either side. The South Lincoln Launch is on river left.
- 5 (RM 31) **Mattamiscontis Stream** (*The little alewife location*) joins the Penobscot shortly below Mahockanock Island.
- 6 (RM 32) **Mohawk Rapids** are Class I-II, with many passages through.
- 7 (RM 34) The **Mohawk Campsite** is opposite the south end of a bar island west of Mohawk Island’s southern tip, just before reaching Penobscot River Cabins. If you miss the campsite, inquire at the cabins, river right.
