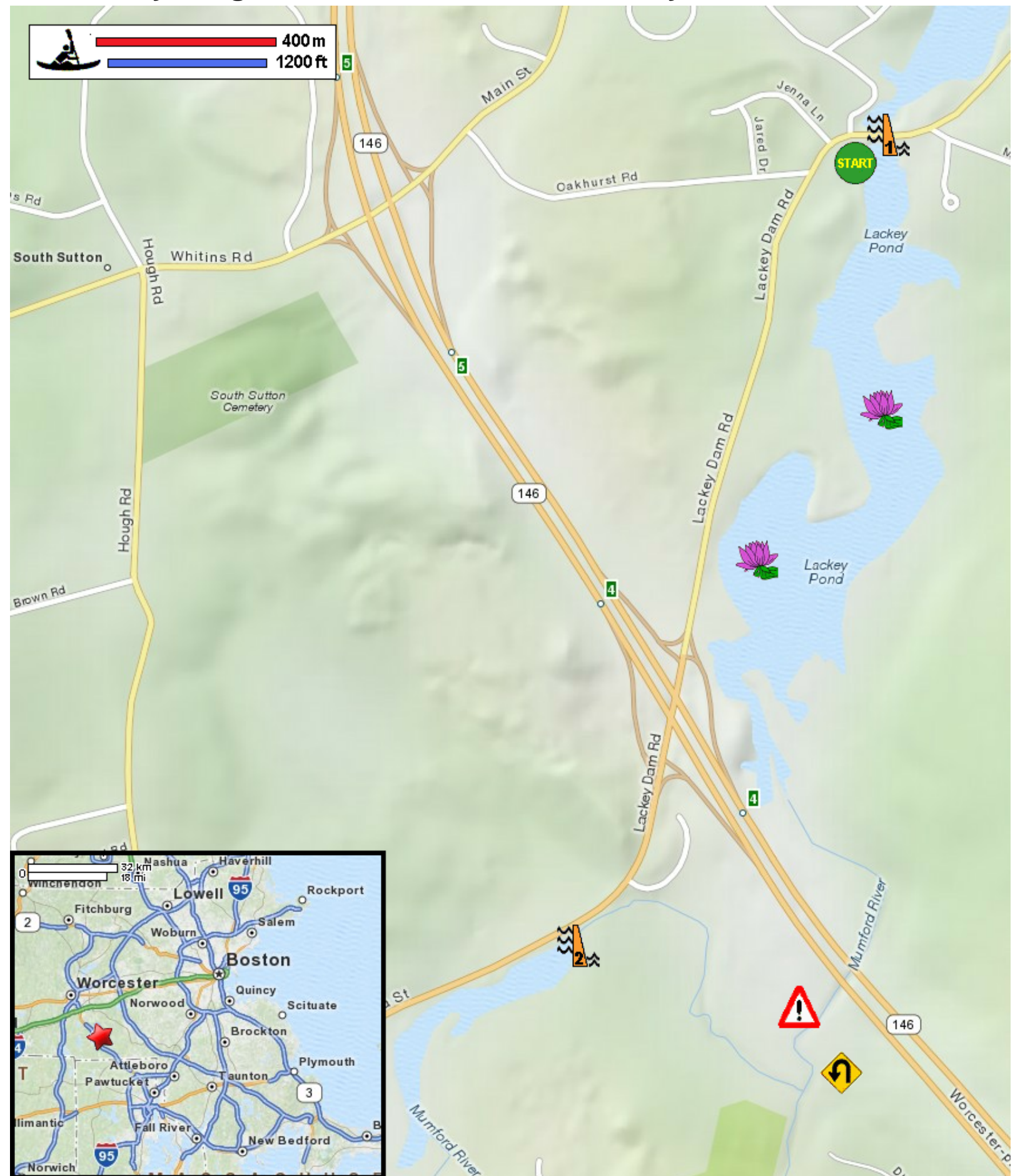










Kayaking on Mumford River and Lackey Pond - in Sutton MA



-  Put in above dam on Lackey Dam Road in Sutton MA.
-  Paddle upstream to the Mumford River inlet and return.
-  River named after a 17th-century hunter who drowned in this river.
-  Pond can be covered with aquatic vegetation in the summer.
-  Estimated round trip distance = 3 miles
-  Downed trees as of June 2012.
-  Lackey Pond Dam
-  Gilboa Pond Dam
